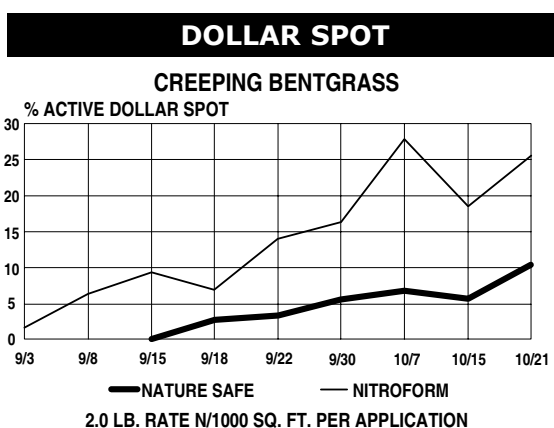
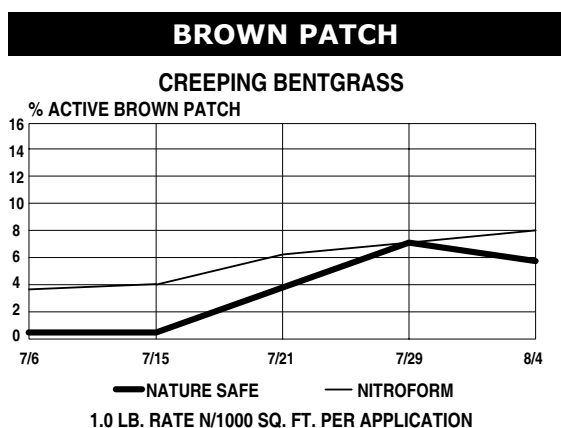

I. Introduction and Procedures

Bentgrass putting greens were inoculated with brown patch on 6/29 and dollar spot on 8/27. The disease severity was estimated visually at approximately 7 day intervals. Fertilizer treatments were applied at rates equivalent to 1 or 2 lbs. N per 1000 sq. ft. on 4/30, 6/30, 8/28, 10/30, 12/30 and on 2/24 the following year. Lesions were measured with Nitroform® used as a standard.

II. Test Results

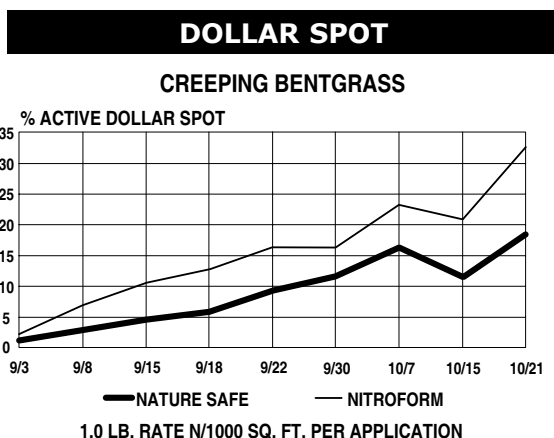


BROWN PATCH

Brown Patch lesions were very low in the test plot with a fertility of 1.0 lb. N per 1000 sq. ft.

DOLLAR SPOT

The dollar spot lesions were very low in the test plots.



III. Conclusion
